The polar vortex is a large area of low pressure and cold air surrounding the Earth's North and South poles. The term vortex refers to the counter-clockwise flow of air that helps keep the colder air close to the poles. The polar vortex spins in the stratosphere, a layer of the atmosphere 10-48 km above the ground and above the troposphere, where most familiar weather patterns develop. Often during winter in the Northern Hemisphere, the polar vortex will become less stable and expand, sending cold Arctic air southward over the United States

Blue stragglers is a class of stars on open or globular clusters that stand out as they are bigger and bluer than the rest of the stars. These are unusually hot and bright stars found in the cores of ancient star clusters known as globulars.
