The death due to AMR is now a leading cause of death worldwide, higher than HIV/AIDS or malaria. The ICMR (Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)) has initiated antibiotic stewardship program (AMSP) on a pilot project across India to control misuse and overuse of antibiotics in hospital wards and ICUs.
