Unmanned ground vehicles are being increasingly used by other armies, including those of the United States, Britain and Russia.

It is a 4.5 generation aircraft which will be used by the Indian Air Force. According to the Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA), LCA Tejas-Mk2 will be rolled out in 2022 and the first flight in early 2023. Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) will be rolled out in 2024 and first flight in 2025. ADA is an autonomous body of the Ministry of Defence. It will use an imported engine.

Better known by his pen name HasratMohani, the activist, Urdu poet and freedom fighter is still greatly revered after his demise on May 13, 1951 in Lucknow.
