1. Ans: C

Explanation: (1) The FSSAI Act 2006 consolidated food related acts and orders. (2) Conducting research on food safety is not the function of FSSAI. (3) Petty manufactures and hawkers come under FSSAI.

Context: Article Will QR Codes improve access to food labels.

FSSAI recommended inclusion of QR Code on food products for accessibility by visually impaired individuals. This QR code should have details of product, ingredients, nutritional information etc.,

Explanation: (1) The act allows the collection of iris and retina scans. (2) The data related to persons detained under preventive laws are not to be recorded.

Context: Article - Why will police stations install DNA systems?

The subsequent meetings of NCRB mentioned collection of DNA and face matching procedure. -These provisions are made for the use of modern techniques in the collection of data related to convicts

However, NCRB cautioned against misuse of data and deployed safeguards to allow only designated officials to access the data.

Explanation: (1) Increase in US Bond yield leads to weakening of Rupee - How?

Given the yield on US Bonds is high , the investors would shift their funds from riskier emerging markets like India to US —> Outflow of dollars —> Increased demand for dollars and decreased

demand for rupee --> weakening of rupee.

Context: Article - Two wrong prescriptions. The Article talks about whether the recent move by RBI to use OMOs to mitigate inflation risk is required or not. It also talks about the impact of Global uncertainties (US Bond yield, Israel-US war) on Indian Economy.

10. Ans: C

Explanation: **(1)** The resignation of speaker is compulsory in Britain .It is not mandatory in India, though resignation is allowed under 10th Schedule. **(2)** The decision of Speaker is final only in the cases of defection. In all other cases of disqualification, the decision of President is considered. **(3)** As per convention, the Deputy Speaker is from opposition party.

Context: Article - Give up impropriety, demonstrate impartiality. The inaction by Maharashtra speaker on the question of disqualification despite orders by the courts, led to concerns over the partial attitude of those holding the post.
